1 INT. HOUSE - DAY

1

A 6 years old child is running in the house holding a balloon, his family is in the house, there are boxes everywhere as they are moving out. He runs to the second floor.

SUPER: BRAZIL, 1879.

2 INT. DAD'S OFFICE - DAY

2

HENRIQUE DUMONT, 47. His father, engineer, is working, he gets mad when the child disturbs him. He stands up angry, he pops the balloon. The child starts crying and runs away.

3 INT. CHILD'S ROOM - DAY

3

The child is crying, his mother walks in.

FRANCISCA DUMONT, 44.

FRANCISCA

What's the matter honey?

4 ALBERTO SANTOS DUMONT, 6.

4

SANTOS DUMONT

I was playing with the balloon and dad pop it.

FRANCISCA

I'm sorry hun, but don't be sad. It's his new job. We get you another one on the way to Cabanju.

Santos Dumont clear his tears.

SANTOS DUMONT

Really?

FRANCISCA

I promise you. By the way, have you finished packing?

SANTOS DUMONT

Not yet.

5

FRANCISCA

Okay, we're going after lunch, make sure you are all packed.

SANTOS DUMONT

Okay mom.

She smiles at him and walks downstairs.

DISSOLVE TO:

5 INT. LOWER FLOOR - DAY

Francisca is finishing to prepare the table with Santos Dumont's sisters.

FRANCISCA

All right everyone! Food is served!

All the 7 kids run to the table, grab a seat and start serving their plates. The dad comes after.

Santos Dumont looks to his father scared.

HENRIQUE

(serious)

Alberto.

Everyone goes quiet.

SANTOS DUMONT

(scared)

Yes dad.

HENRIQUE

Don't you EVER, bother me again when I'm working, do you understand?

Santos Dumont's eyes waters.

SANTOS DUMONT

Yes father, I'm sorry.

FRANCISCA

Henrique, don't be harsh on the kids. They're kids, they need to play.

HENRIQUE

They need to learn. And I did NOT speak with you.

Embarrassed, Santos Dumont stops eating and runs upstairs.

FRANCISCA

See? Look what you did.

Henrique keeps eating. Francisca follows Santos Dumont.

6 INT. SANTOS DUMONT'S BEDROOM - DAY

6

Santos Dumont is crying on his bed. Francisca walks in.

FRANCISCA

Son, don't be sad.

SANTOS DUMONT

Father always treats me like this.

FRANCISCA

Look son, you're old enough now, and you need to understand your father is a busy man. He's the reason we have food on the table.

SANTOS DUMONT

I know, but I didn't do anything wrong, I just walked into his office by mistake, and he pop my balloon. I didn't mean to disturb him.

FRANCISCA

Oh Alberto, try to forget this, okay?

SANTOS DUMONT

Okay.

FRANCISCA

I will talk to him. In the meantime, make sure you're packed.

SANTOS DUMONT

I will. Thanks mom.

Francisca smiles and walks away.

DISSOLVE TO:

7 INT/EXT. TRAIN STATION - DAY

7

The train arrives.

FRANCISCA

I hope you didn't forget anything, it'll be a long way and we will not come back.

They get in the train and walks to their first class cabin. They put their bags on the top shelf.

8 INT. TRAIN - DAY

8

Santos Dumont is sitting next to the window, looking outside. The train starts to move.

ANGLE. While looking outside, his face is reflexing on the window, TIME PASSES and Santos Dumont gets older.

SUPER: FRANCE, 1897.

9 EXT. PARIS' TRAIN STATION - DAY

9

The train arrives. Santos Dumont walks out the train holding a suitcase. Outside the train station, he finds a taxi and hops in.

SANTOS DUMONT

(speaking in French)
University of Paris please.

TAXI DRIVER

(speaking in French)

Yes.

The car drives away.

10 EXT/INT. UNIVERSITY OF PARIS - DAY

10

Santos Dumont pays the driver and walks into the university. He finds a flyer stand and grabs a map. He seems confused. He stops a group of students.

SANTOS DUMONT

(speaking in French)
I'm sorry, where can I find the
engineering's wing?

The student point the direction.

STUDENT

(speaking in French)
That way to the right.

SANTOS DUMONT

(speaking in French)

Thank you.

Santos Dumont follows the direction.

He arrives the engineering's wings, he passes through a lot of doors with numbers, until he finds a door with a sign. AERONAUTIC ENGINEERING. He knocks the door and walks in.

11 INT. AERONAUTIC ENGINEERING - DAY

11

There are a 3 people dressed with suits. They look at him.

MAN 1

Are you okay? How can we help?

SANTOS DUMONT

Is this the aeronautic engineering?

MAN 2

That's what the door says, isn't it?

SANTOS DUMONT

Eh ... I guess.

He opens his suitcase.

SANTOS DUMONT (CONT'D)

I want to know if anyone of you can teach me more about this.

He gets a book: Andrée - Au Pôle Nord en ballon.

MAN 1

Balloons? Who are you?

SANTOS DUMONT

My name is Alberto Santos Dumont, but you can call me Dumont.

MAN 1

Okay, Dumont, my name is Pierre, I'm the professor of mechanics for the engineering courses.

PIERRE, 48.

PIERRE

These are Marc and Andre.

MARC, 45.

MARC

Nice to meet you, I'm professor of chemistry.

ANDRE, 42. He says hi with his hands.

ANDRE

Professor of physics.

PIERRE

What do you want to know about the book?

SANTOS DUMONT

I want to know more about how balloons work.

PIERRE

The balloons?

ANDRE

I think I can explain really quick.

Andre walks to a black board and starts drawing.

ANDRE (CONT'D)

Long story short, the gas generated by the fire fills the balloon, and since that gas is lighter than the air the balloon flies.

SANTOS DUMONT

I know that, but how can you control it?

ANDRE

Oh, I think the best person to teach you that is Julio.

SANTOS DUMONT

Where can I find him?

PIERRE

He'll probably be in his office, 2nd floor.

SANTOS DUMONT

Thanks.

Santos Dumont packs the book and walks away.

12 INT. JULIO'S OFFICE - DAY

12

Julio is sitting on his desk writing some notes. He hears the door being knocked.

JULIO, 41, is sitting on his desk with a sign showing coordinator.

JULIO

Come on in!

The door opens, Santos Dumont walks in.

SANTOS DUMONT

Excuse me, are you Julio?

JULIO

Yes, how can I help?

Santos Dumont walks next to his desk and stands the hand.

SANTOS DUMONT

Nice to meet you Julio, my name is Alberto Santos Dumont.

They shake hands.

JULIO

Nice to meet you, what can I do for you?

SANTOS DUMONT

I heard you know how to fly a balloon.

JULIO

Yes, why?

SANTOS DUMONT

Can you teach me?

Julio looks to Santos Dumont and looks back down.

JULIO

I don't have time for that. Go find someone else.

SANTOS DUMONT

But I came --

JULIO

-- And close the door behind you.

BANG, Santos Dumont puts a 20 Francs note in front of him.

JULIO (CONT'D)

What is this?

SANTOS DUMONT

Your payment ... per hour.

Julio looks at him for a second. He grabs the note.

JULIO

4 o'clock, at the backyard.

SANTOS DUMONT

Thank you very much. I'll see you at 4.

Santos Dumont leaves the room.

DISSOLVE TO:

13 EXT. UNIVERSITY BACKYARD - DAY

13

Julio arrives. Excited, Santos Dumont stands up.

JULTO

You're on time.

SANTOS DUMONT

Always.

JULIO

All right, let's start.

Julio opens his bag and grabs a book.

JULIO (CONT'D)

Hot air balloons are basically filled with the gas liberated from the fire, which makes the balloon to fly, the balloon will travel according to where the wind will blow. Controlling it is the art.

SANTOS DUMONT

I know that so far.

JULIO

Good, one less step to teach you. The art of steering it starts to the difference of altitudes ...

(While Julio keeps the explanation, a music starts from the background while Julio's voice fades out and a real clip about balloons fades in).

DISSOLVE TO:

14 EXT./INT. LACHAMBRE & MACHURON'S HANGAR - MORNING

14

WINTER. Santos Dumont walks into a hangar outside Paris. LACHAMBRE, 37 is at the reception.

SUPER: FRANCE, 1898.

LACHAMBRE

Good morning gentleman, welcome to Lachambre & Machuron. How can I assist you today?

SANTOS DUMONT

I would like to fly in a balloon.

LACHAMBRE

That's perfect. We're preparing the balloon just outside now. We can take you in for 250 Francs.

SANTOS DUMONT

Is it any dangerous?

LACHAMBRE

Not at all.

SANTOS DUMONT

And how much is the descent damage?

LACHAMBRE

That would depend on the aeronaut, my nephew Machuron. However, he has ascended dozens of times and he has never had a descent damage ...

Anyways, no matter what happens, you will pay nothing more than the 250 Francs.

SANTOS DUMONT

It sounds good to me.

Santos Dumont pays the 250 Francs.

LACHAMBRE

This way please.

Lachambre shows him the back door, they walk outside. MACHURON, 32, is preparing the balloon. There is another person there.

SANTOS DUMONT

This looks amazing.

Machuron looks back.

MACHURON

Oh, welcome mister ... --

SANTOS DUMONT

-- Dumont, Alberto Dumont.

MACHURON

Dumont, nice to meet you. You can call me Machuron, are you joining us today?

SANTOS DUMONT

Yes, I am.

MACHURON

Great. Come have a look.

Machuron walks inside the balloon, Santos Dumont follows him.

MACHURON (CONT'D)

What do you think eh?

SANTOS DUMONT

It looks so beautiful.

MACHURON

Yes it does ... It does indeed.

Machuron lost time while appreciating the balloon.

MACHURON (CONT'D)

Oh, it should be ready by now. Shall we?

SANTOS DUMONT

Please, after you.

They walk out the balloon and embark in the basket. They ascend. During the trip, Santos Dumont FOLLOWS the MACHURON MANEUVERS.

They fly over Paris, Santos Dumont feels stupefied with the view, smiling like a little kid.

They return to the office, the other person thanks them and leaves the scene.

MACHURON

So Dumont, what did you think?

SANTOS DUMONT

It was amazing, I couldn't believe how beautiful Paris was from the sky.

LACHAMBRE

I'm glad you enjoyed. We can do this as much as you want.

SANTOS DUMONT

Actually, what are the chances of building my own?

LACHAMBRE

Building your own?

MACHURON

I've seen people liking to fly, but building your own is a totally different story.

LACHAMBRE

I don't even know how to start. Because it's not only building but you need to learn how to fly it.

SANTOS DUMONT

I know, I've been getting classes at the university and I watched Mr. Machuron's maneuvers. I understood every single movement he did, and I think I can do it.

MACHURON

Wow. I don't know what to say. Uncle, any ideas?

LACHAMBRE

Well, if you really wanna do it, I'm not saying it's easy, but the factory we work for just got some silk samples from Japan, we're plaining to build a new balloon with it, I can ask the manager if you can help or watch.

MACHURON

That's true. Beautiful silk and the weight in insignificant. It should fly like a dove.

SANTOS DUMONT

That's great, where is the place?

LACHAMBRE

The factory is in the heart of Paris, meet me at the Eifel Tower at 5 in the morning and we go together.

SANTOS DUMONT

16 EXT. EIFEL TOWER - DAY

16

Lachambre arrives, Santos Dumont is having a coffee on a bench.
